Our school initiatives are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2016, we focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our 2016 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our initiatives to ensure that every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Employed an Explicit Teaching Coach to partner teachers as they become more effective in using the 16 Elements of Explicit Teaching.
- Implemented the Sight, Sounds Program SSP, in Prep with familiarisation in Year One.
- The research validated intervention program Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) has been reviewed and continued.
- Data and Literacy Coaches have led teachers in data analysis & explicit instruction practices.
- **Student performance data** (DHSS Assessment Framework) has been reviewed & enhanced.
- **Teacher capability** to analyze student performance data to develop differentiated programs to improve student outcomes has occurred. Plans have been written for students.
- Collegial Learning Networks have been enhanced by the strengthening of a **Collegial Coaching Program** and the extention into a Professional Learning Community.
- The Learning Connections Program has been embedded and is addressing the developmental immaturities and lack of school readiness that had presented in at least 30% of the students entering our school.
- A **Read it Again Program** (Support A Talker) has been implemented & has so far sucesfully serviced 40 students.
- Reluctant readers have been targeted with high interest low level resources.
- The Pre Prep and Pre School Playgroup programs have been implemented with success.
- **PAT Online Testing** fully fully implemented.
- Increased Speech Therapist time by 2 days beyond the staffing allocation
