## Our school initiatives are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2020, we focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our 2020 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes.

We continue to implement our initiatives to ensure that every student succeeds.

## Initiatives implemented include:

- Teacher Assistant Program successfully enacted as planned.
- Introduced and effectively manged the employment of a Student Support Teacher and Teacher Aide to assit our students become more engaged with learning.
- Extended into Year Four the Sight, Sounds & Pics Program (SSP), with familiarisation in Year Five/Six.
- The research validated intervention program **Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI)** has been reviewed and continued.
- Data and Literacy Coaches have led teachers in data analysis & AAP practices.
- **Teacher capability** to analyze student performance data and dispositions to develop differentiated programs to improve student outcomes has effectively occurred. .
- Collegial Learning Networks have been enhanced by the strengthening of a Coaching Program and the extention into a Professional Learning Community.
- The Learning Connections Program has been enhanced and is addressing the
  developmental immaturities and lack of school readiness that had presented in at least 30%
  of the students entering our school.
- An "Oral Languauge in the Early Years" program has been continued & has so far successfully serviced 120 students in three years, across our Prep Cohorts.
- The Pre Prep and Pre School Playgroup programs have been enhanced with success.
- Speech Therapist time has been increased by 2 days beyond the staffing allocation.
